What to Bring

- ESSENTIALS -

- Pillow, sheet & blanket or sleeping bag
- Towel
- Liquid Soap (not bar soap)
- Shampoo & Conditioner
- Running shoes for walking in the pastures and for hiking

- OTHER -

- Rain gear in case of rain
- Sweatshirt or light jacket
- Mosquito repellent
- Sunscreen
- Flashlight

Optional Things

- Musical Instruments

Things to Remember

- Show respect by picking things up and tidying up throughout your stay
- Conserve Electricity – we are on SOLAR
- Stay within our property boundaries (map)
- Respect the House, all animals on property, and each other
- Put away food right after use
- No food or drinks in the Pods
- Take out garbage before it overflows
- Always plan on leaving things **better** than you found them

Practical Suggestions / Additional "What to Bring"

- For Kitchen, bring: toilet paper, napkins, paper towels, tall kitchen trash can liners, & dish towels.
- For each Pod bring: Liquid or foam hand soap, napkins or paper towels, NO bar soap.
- Bring: Extra Notebook/Pens/Pencils, Extra Bibles, Board Games (we have some board and card games), First Aid Kit, Bug spray.
- As a group you might want to bring an inexpensive shampoo and conditioner for each pod so all 30 kids do not have to bring it individually.

LODGING

- Total beds available 38
- Ideal group size 30
- Minimum group size 15
- There are six separate living areas called Pods, total beds 30
- Each Pod sleeps 5 and has its own bathroom and shower. *An additional mattress can be added per Pod. Spare mattresses provided.
- Each Pod must have adequate supervision [1 adult per pod]
- Additional sleeping for leaders and support staff, total beds 8: 2 conference rooms, 2 annex rooms.
- Conference rooms use main bathroom in hallway and the 2 annex rooms are attached to the last pod on each side and can share Pod bathrooms.

OTHER

- There is a washer and dryer on the property, but do not plan on using it unless we have unusually wet conditions.
- Do not use any tape, screws, or nails on any surfaces of the home, including walls, railings and floors.
- All garbage to be removed from property at the end of your stay. IMPORTANT.

Important Property Information

- Kid's House is on 130 Acres
- We are a working ranch.
- House is solar powered and electrical energy conservation is a high priority. We use propane for all cooking
- Media room, downstairs, ideal for acoustic or miking instruments, but no excessive loud instruments.
- Internet: the internet access is password protected. Leaders can nominate 3 people to get access on their devices.
- We ask that you clean up after. We supply rags and cleaning supplies.
- Use outside showers after beach.
- Noise out at 10 & Lights out at 11. Help us be good neighbors.
- We encourage kids to ask lots of questions and fall in love with the ranch. We want to consider all who come here as part of our extended family.
